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Dear Parents & Students,

Over the next few weeks all students will be meeting with their guidance counselors to determine their course requests for next school year. All courses and pathways of study can be found in the 2018-2019 Program of Studies which is posted on the FLHS Guidance website. Parents can access student course requests on the Genesis Parent Portal after the one to one student/counselor meeting has taken place. Your input is an integral part of the process so please review and approve of all course requests. **It is also important to remember that once a student requests his/her electives and classes they cannot be changed after April 2018.**

Placement in Honors, Advance Placement and/or International Baccalaureate courses are contingent upon students meeting criteria in the following three areas: academic achievement in current courses, cumulative GPA, and teacher recommendations. Students who would like to take Advanced Placement, Honors, or International Baccalaureate courses, but do not meet the three criteria above, may choose to participate in the Appeal Process. Appeal Forms are due to the Guidance Office on March 15th, 2018.

- **GPA Requirement:** Minimum GPA to enter Honors courses must be at least 3.0; minimum GPA to enter AP/IB courses must be a 3.5

This is in addition to our new classes offered in 2017-2018 & in 2016-2017: Korean, Mandarin Chinese, Athletic Coaching (a hybrid course), Yearbook II, IB Music I, Female Voices in Literature, Open Ingenuity Lab, Innovation & Invention, Forensics, Botany and Floral Design, Robotics, 3D Design II, Dance, Statistics and Probability, Marketing Education/Cooperative Work, Topics in Computers and Technology Honors, Sports & Entertainment Management (hybrid course), Myth, Fantasy & Science Fiction/The Graphic Novel, Movies and Literature, Journalism II, and Italian Honors. The Program of Studies includes all course descriptions and prerequisites. All course offerings are subject to change and run based on classroom enrollment.
