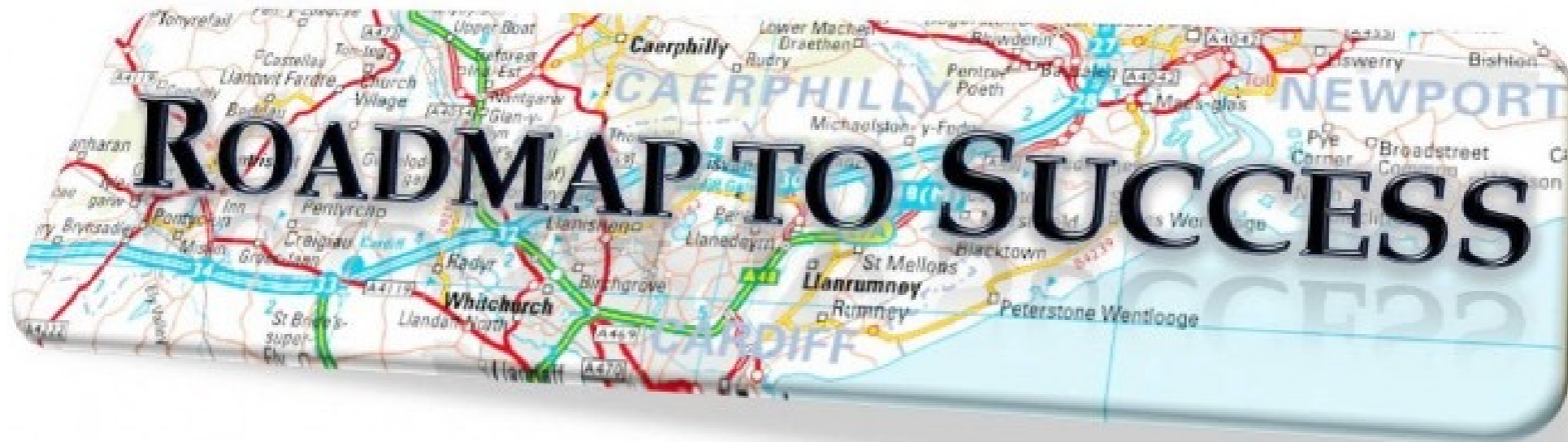


WELCOME TO FORT LEE HIGH SCHOOL

School Counseling Services

Course selection, grades, academic and personal progress, self-esteem, motivation, peer relations, study skills, and prevent cases in Harassment, Intimidation and Bullying (HIB)

Post-secondary planning:

Graduation Course Requirements

Each student must earn a minimum of **120 credits** to graduate.

English- 20 credits (4 years)

Math- 15 credits (3 years including Algebra, Geometry and content equivalent)

History- 15 credits (3 years including World History and US History I and US History II)

Science- 15 credits (3 years including Biology and one additional lab science)

Physical Education/Health- 20 credits (4 years; one per year in school)

World Language-5 credits (1 year required; 2 years is highly recommended as it is required for four year college admission)

Graduation Course Requirements Cont'd

21st Century Skills- 5 credits (practical art)

Visual and Performing Art-5 credits (fine art)

Financial Literacy- 2.5 credits (Principles of Personal Finance)

Creative Writing- 2.5 credits *

School & Community Service- 2.5 credits (50 hours)

*Students enrolled in AOF or IB will take Intro to Business/Entrepreneurship or IB Economics in place of Creative Writing and Principles of Personal Finance.



Community Service



- All students are required to complete 50 hours of community service.
- Students can sign up for community service in any year prior to graduation with Mr. Cuzzo our SAC Counselor. We HIGHLY recommend to begin hours freshman year.
- All assignments must be pre-approved and signed by parents and Mr. Cuzzo.

Starting with the Class of 2021, students will only have two pathways to meet the high school graduation assessments requirements:

- (1) Pass the ELA 10 and Algebra 1 assessments
- (2) The submission by the district of a student portfolio appeals process

Excused Absences

A school may have a day in session that would not be counted as a day in membership for a particular student for the following reasons (New Jersey School Register, Ch.3):

- o **Religious observance** (N.J.A.C. 6A:32-8.3(h));
- o **A college visit** (up to 3 days per school year, only for students in grades 11 and 12);
- o **“Take Our Children to Work Day”** (pursuant to the memo issued by the Commissioner to all districts on April 25, 2017) or other rule issued by the Commissioner;
 - o **Participation in observance of Veterans Day** (N.J.S.A. 18A: 36-13.2) or district board of election membership activities (N.J.S.A. 18A: 36-33); or
 - o **The closure of a busing district that prevents a student from having transportation to the receiving school.**

Student Code of Conduct

The Code of Conduct is designed to promote a healthy and safe school environment that encourages the academic, social and emotional development of all students.

All students at Fort Lee High School are bound by law, policies of the Board of Education, and the administrative regulations of the school district.

Zero Tolerance for Discriminatory Language

Any Staff member of the Fort Lee High School Community witnessing the use of discriminatory language will report the student to the designated grade level assistance principal and the student will immediately receive a 3 day out of school suspension. Singing a song is not an excuse.

○ Examples of Unacceptable Attire

Shredded, ripped, or cut-off clothing, bare midriff, see through clothing that exposes the torso, underwear that is visible, beachwear, pajamas, strapless tops, halter tops, cut-off shirts, and sleeveless athletic jerseys are not permitted. For **female** students, tank tops may be worn if not cut too low around the neck; clothing should not be too revealing. For **male** students, tank tops are not permitted.

Any clothing or patches that have writing or pictures that include the following are not permitted.

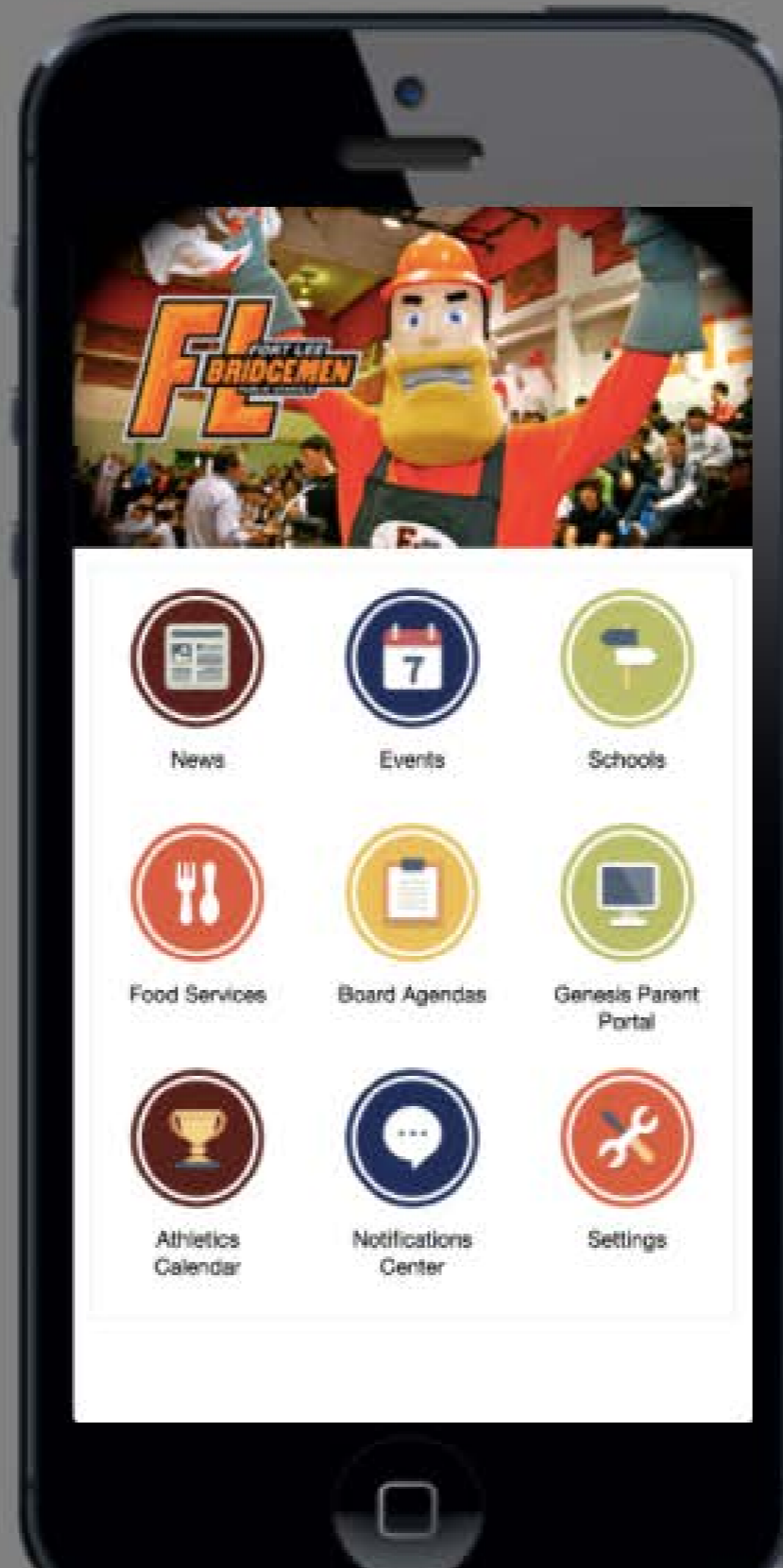
