## Scheduling: (Will be done with me 1 on 1 during Feb & March)

Review transcript, GPA, and check credit/course requirements
Choose grade 12 courses related to the major you wish to pursue (Review the program of studies)
File appeals using the google form for classes you didn't meet the criteria and want to enroll (DUE 3/19)
Correct any attendance issues and register for credit recovery if it was already lost
Naviance:
Login and make sure you can access the site, it's a good idea to use your personal email for naviance
Update your parent's information (email and phone number) under the "about me" tab.
Search for colleges using the Advanced College Search feature and research the entrance criteria.
Add colleges to the "Colleges I'm Thinking About" list based on your academic profile (safe, target, reach)
**Complete the Pre-College Survey located under the "About Me" tab (DUE 5/1)**
Keep a concise list of extracurricular activities you have participated in using the <b>resume feature</b>
College Preparation:
Ask two teachers to write you a recommendation. One from the Humanities field and one from the STEM
field BY THE END OF JUNIOR YEAR. (In person first, or through email if virtual, then put on naviance)
Schedule campus tours/visits for the spring & summer and attend college fairs (virtual or in-person)
Decide what you want in terms of: Big School / Small School Dorm / Commute City / Rural Major? How far?
Review the common application writing prompts on naviance and start ESSAYS over the summer.
Create a Common Application account (commonapp.org) over the summer.
Keep your raise.me scholarship account updated and search for scholarships (fastweb, companies, etc.)
Keep free / reduced lunch status updated with the office to qualify for fee waivers (SAT, score reports, apps)
ATHLETES – Register on the NCAA eligibility center if you intend to play Division 1 or 2 athletics
Testing:
Create a collegeboard account (used to retrieve SAT scores, register for tests, and search for colleges)
Review PSAT score from October's administration on collegeboard and utilize Khan Academy for prep
Register for one of the Spring SAT or ACT administrations online (collegeboard.org or act.org)
