The General Application and the applicant's academic records, including most recent report card, transcript, and test scores, will be provided to the high school scholarship committee. Selection criteria vary by scholarship and may be based on any or all of the following: merit, need, purpose, achievement and contributions to the school and/or community. All students are highly encouraged to apply. Selection criteria are established by the participating organizations. Awards range from one hundred to several thousand dollars.

Your General Application must be completed and submitted electronically. Applications are due by 3:00 PM Thursday, March 28, 2024. Applications will not be accepted after this date. Students must also submit the FLHS Class of 2024 Scholarship Opportunities Checklist to the School Counseling Office. The checklist is included at the end of this booklet. If needed, hard copies are available in the School Counseling Office.
